Ideal qualifications include a blend of artistic creativity, musical proficiency, and strong leadership skills, coupled with a deep spiritual grounding and a passion for facilitating worship experiences.

- **Musical Talent and Passion:** Possess a strong ability and passion for music, demonstrated through proficiency in musical performance and a genuine commitment to worship through music.
- Leadership and Collaboration: Exhibit leadership qualities such as teamwork, communication, and cooperation, along with a willingness to work collaboratively with others in planning and executing worship services.
- **Spiritual Discernment and Faith:** A deep understanding of the role of music in facilitating worship and spiritual growth as a believer and follower of Jesus Christ.

Responsibilities of the Position

- **Participate in the coordination and Planning Worship Experiences:** Collaborate with the Pastor, Creative Worship Team, to coordinate and plan worship experiences that incorporate music, visual arts, and other creative elements to enhance spiritual engagement.
- Leadership of Creative Worship Team: Take the lead in guiding and managing the Creative Worship Team, serving as a voting member and providing direction to ensure cohesive and impactful worship experiences.
- Leadership of Primary Music Ensemble: Assume leadership over the primary music ensemble, such as the choir, ensuring excellence in musical contributions to worship services.
- Supervision of Music for All Services: Oversee the selection and preparation of music for all services, <u>both Sunday and non-Sunday</u>, to maintain consistency and excellence in musical offerings.
- **Management of Music Staff and Volunteers:** Provide leadership and support to music volunteers, report to the Senior Pastor to facilitate ongoing improvement and development within the music program.
- **Budget Management and Resource Planning:** Collaborating with Senior pastor and Finance Chair to ensure effective allocation of resources for support of creative worship initiatives.

- **Coordination of non-Sunday Worship Experiences/Holidays:** Coordinate with Pastor and Creative worship team for non-Sunday (Holiday), ensuring that these special services are meaningful and reflective of the significance of the occasion.
- **Maintenance of Musical Instruments:** Take responsibility for the maintenance and upkeep of all musical instruments, including storage and care, to ensure their optimal functioning and longevity.
- Vacation coverage Contact and provide backup service for Worship services.
- Weekly staff meetings Attend Weekly staff meetings. Bi-Monthly (every other month) meet directly with the Senior Pastor.
- **Ark of Learning** Collaborate with the Director of the Ark of Learning to develop musical opportunities that foster spiritual growth among the students and deepen their connection with the Mt. Moriah congregation.
