The Basic ERT Class is being offered on November 9. This 8 hour class will teach you how to assist survivors of natural disasters in their time of need. You will learn how to provide



a Christian presence while taking steps to prevent further damage to the family's personal property; this may include tarping, debris removal, cleaning out flooded homes, etc. FEMA recognizes this training to enter a disaster scene.

The recertification class will take place during the morning session and is only for those who have completed the basic course and are within one year of the date their badge expired.
